Item 2- Educational Background and Business Experience

Brian K. Mirau, born in 1961, is a graduate of McMurry University in Abilene, Texas where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. He also holds the LUTCF designation.

The Life Underwriter Training Council Fellow (LUTCF) designation is jointly conferred by the National Association of Insurance and Financial Advisors (NAIFA) and The American College. The LUTCF designation represents accomplishment and professionalism, helping life insurance professionals to establish strong and lasting

client relationships. To earn the LUTCF designation, one must successfully complete 300 designation credits (or 5 courses), one ethics course, and be a NAIFA member in good standing during the conferment year. Courses in the LUTCF program are either in an 8-week or 12-week format.

Brian has been a Financial Advisor with Madison Avenue Securities, LLC. since 2008. Prior to his affiliation with Madison Avenue Securities, Brian was a Financial Advisor with Lincoln Financial, Ameritas Investment Corp, and Kalos Capital, Inc. from 2004 to 2008.

In addition to being a Registered Investment Advisor, MAS is also a broker-dealer and FINRA member firm, engaged in the business of selling securities.

Brian may have a conflict of interest when providing financial planning services because he and MAS may receive additional compensation if the client chooses to execute transactions or purchase securities or insurance products through MAS. These will generally include sales commissions paid by product sponsors and trailing commissions on mutual fund shares. Clients are under no obligation to purchase products recommended by IARs through the IAR or MAS or its affiliates.

MAS, its IARs, and affiliates may, but are not obligated to, purchase or sell or recommend for purchase or sale a security which they may purchase or sell for their own accounts or the account of any other client. MAS has procedures dealing with insider trading, employee related accounts, front running and other issues that may present a potential conflict when such purchases, sales, or recommendations are made. In general, these policies and procedures are intended to eliminate, to the extent possible, the adverse effect on clients of any such potential conflicts of interest.
